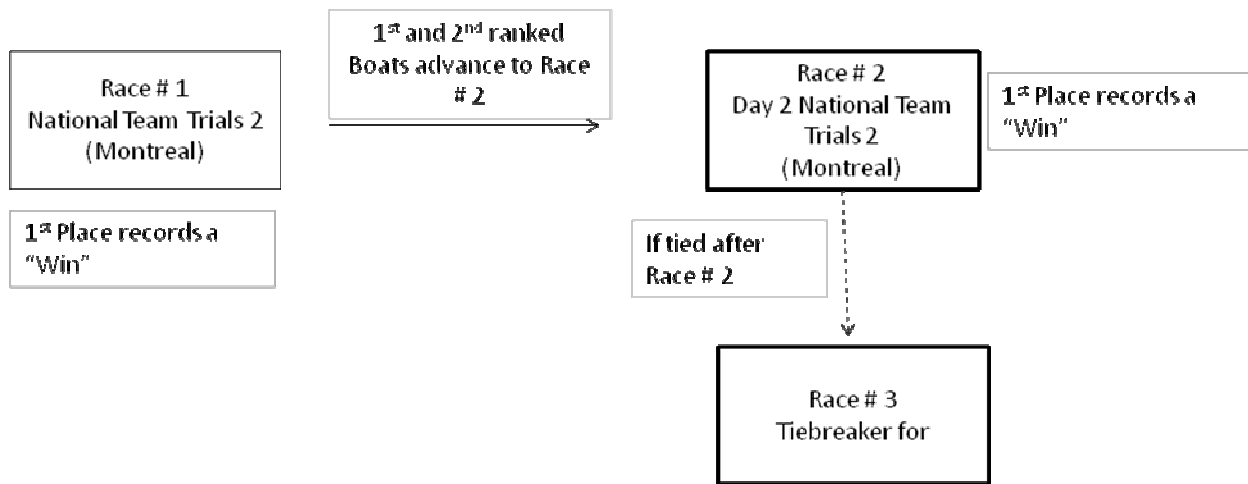


Amendment to Olympic Games Men's K-1 200m Selection in 2012 London Olympic Games Team Specific Nomination Criteria

APPENDIX A:

General Selection Concept:

- Men's K-1 200m selection will occur during National Team Trials II in Montreal, QC
 - Dates of Competition: June 22nd – 24th
- Athlete **must win 2 out of 3 races** in order to be nominated to the Olympic Team.



Specific Criteria:

1. **Race # 1 (Day 1):**
The first (1st) and second (2nd) placed athletes in the Men's K-1 200m A Final will be selected to advance to, and compete in the second final or race for Men's K-1 200m nomination.
The Men's K-1 200 will follow regular Heats, semi-finals progression.
2. The winner of **Race # 1** will record a "win"
3. **Race # 2 (Day 2 Morning):**
The first (1st) and second (2nd) place athletes *only* will compete in Race # 2. The winner of Race # 2 will record a "Win"
4. If following **Race # 2**, neither athlete has recorded 2 "wins", the tie breaker will be **Race # 3**.
5. **Race # 3:**
The winner of Race # 3 (tiebreaker) will record "win" # 2.
6. The athlete who records 2 "wins" in those events will be nominated to the COC Olympic Games Team.

Amendment to World Cup Nomination for Men's K-1 200m in 2012 National Team Selection Criteria:

APPENDIX A Senior World Cup 1 and 2:

Men's K-1 200m:

- First placed athlete at Trials 1, who has met the Senior Performance Indicator, and not involved in the men's K-2 200m process will be nominated to the World Cup Team.
- In the case where the first placed athlete has not met the Senior Performance Indicator or is involved in the men's K-2 200m selection process, the highest ranked U23 athlete who has met the U23 Performance Indicator will be eligible to be nominated to the World Cup Team.
