PURPOSE:

NTT2 will be used to determine the following:

1. JR World Championship Team selection;
2. JR PanAm Team selection;
3. U17 Canada Cup/CANAMEX Team selection;
4. U17 Olympic Hopes Team selection;
5. Senior Discipline Pools for World Championships assessment;
6. U23 Discipline Pools for U23 World Championships assessment;
7. Second win for Paracanoe World Championships Team selection;
8. The first competition used for D-card combined ranking lists for 12 months carding.

Competition Specifics

1. The format will include Junior and Senior events (details below). All athletes should consult the [2017 National Team Selection Policies](#) posted on the CKC website for more details.
2. This competition is open to all athletes:
 - i. Who hold Canadian citizenship or "Permanent Residency status" or whose participation is approved by the Chief Technical Officer;
 - AND**
 - ii. Whose participation is approved by a National Team Coach, Provincial Team Coach, or Club Head Coach who holds full Level 3 NCCP or Comp Dev certification.
3. In order to participate all entrants must be registered with a CKC (SRD) member club for the 2017 season and must be in "good standing" with CKC and their member club.
4. All payments for **any** outstanding accounts must be made by cheque, cash, email transfer (sclare@canoekayak.ca) or credit card payment **prior to the Coaches' meeting**. Athletes who do not settle their account with CKC risk being disqualified from the Trials event.
5. We will communicate advancement specifics after the entries are closed and the number of heats for each event is known.
6. Athletes who miss a race or scratch from a race after the coaches' meeting will be required to pay a penalty of \$75 prior to the end of the same race day or next event in which they are entered in order to continue racing and for their results to stand.

Preliminary Schedule and event details

Preliminary schedule will be released the week of **June 9, 2017**

A first draft of the draw will be produced by **June 16, 2017**

A final schedule of events will be produced by **June 16, 2017**

The High-Performance Committee reserves the right to change published race schedules and the advancement format in order to provide the fairest possible racing and selection conditions to all participating athletes.

1. The competition will be run with modified ICF racing rules. A copy of the ICF racing rules can be found on the ICF website www.canoeicf.com and the modified rules will be reviewed with the coaches at the pre-competition meeting on **Thursday June 22, 2017 @ 5:00pm at Mic Mac AAC**
2. For advancements; ICF rules will be followed up to 4 heats. For all events with 5 or more heats, there will be one less final than there are heats (i.e. 6 heats = 5 finals – A, B, C, D, E and F).
3. **Boat Numbers:** The Organizing Committees **will not** be responsible for providing boat numbers. Participating clubs and athletes will be responsible for providing their own regulation size boat numbers for National Team Trials.
4. Anti-doping controls may be conducted on a random basis in accordance with the Canoe Kayak Canada's Anti-Doping Policy and Doping Control Program.

Registration Details

1. Registration will open Friday June 2, 2017

Deadline for this competition is 4pm Friday June 9, 2017

Registrations are to be done through the [PadTrac Online Entry System](#) no later than 4:00pm EST June 9th. After this date, any entries that are accepted will be considered a "post-entry" and a \$20.00 post-entry fee will be levied for each event entered.

A "post entry" will only be included if a lane is available, as no additional heats will be added for post-entries. Your cooperation is appreciated, as it is necessary to allocate lanes, seed the heats and prepare the program for the event in advance.

Faxed, mailed or emailed entries will not be accepted.

2. The entry fee for 2017 National Team Trials 2 is \$ 200.00 per athlete.

3. All competing athletes must have a completed and signed waiver form. Athletes under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian's signature. The forms can be found on the event page for [NTT2 on the CKC website](#).
4. Online registration will be the only method of entering the National Team Trials. Only coaches and club registrars can enter athletes for National Team Trials on PadTrac. Athletes can view their entries and profile online but cannot change or alter them. To enter online or view a profile please go to www.ckcpadtrac.ca
